WHEREAS, the Hudson River-Black River Regulating District desires and is required to establish a District-based alcohol and drug testing program which would cover drivers of commercial motor vehicles in compliance with the Department of Transportation Regulations codified at 49 CFR Part 40, and 49 CFR Part 382, and pursuant to the Omnibus Transportation Employee Testing Act of 1991, enacted October 28, 1991 and

WHEREAS, this policy shall apply to all District employees who operate commercial motor vehicles and are subject to the commercial driver's license (CDL) requirements established by the DOT, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the policy is to establish a program to help prevent accidents and injuries resulting from the misuse of alcohol and or drugs by covered drivers,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of the Hudson River-Black River Regulating District does hereby approve and accept the policy entitled HUDSON RIVER-BLACK RIVER REGULATING DISTRICT POLICY ON DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING. Said policy having been provided and approved by the District's alcohol and drug testing administrator (Jefferson-Lewis-Hamilton-Herkimer-Oneida BOCES).
