WHEREAS, the mission of Hudson River-Black River Regulating District requires a robust and capable workforce; and


WHEREAS, Michael Chase was promoted from Maintenance Specialist to Assistant Foreman in the Hudson River Area effective March 31, 2022; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board authorizes the hiring of a Maintenance Specialist in the Hudson River Area, to be filled by the most qualified candidate as determined by applicant interviews in accordance with the provisions of the current CSEA agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the successful candidate be compensated in accordance with the provisions of the current CSEA agreement at a FY 2022-2023 salary range of \$38,980-48,896.
